VI. HEALTH HAZARD DATA: Primary routes of entry: INHALATION, SKIN.

Hazard Identification:

INHALATION: May cause facial flushing, especially after alcohol ingestion. Acute overexposure may result in bluish tint to skin, headaches, dizziness, confusion, or coma.

SKIN: Contact with skin may result in irritation. Toxic amounts can be absorbed through the skin and result in headaches, dizziness, nausea, confusion, or coma.

EYE CONTACT: Contact with eyes may result in irritation.

INGESTION: May result in headaches, dizziness, nausea, confusion, or coma.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:

INHALATION: Move person to fresh air and aid in breathing if necessary. Contact a physician.

SKIN: Wash with soap and water. Wash clothing before re-use. Contact a physician.

EYE CONTACT: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Contact a physician if irritation develops.

INGESTION: Dilute by drinking water, then induce vomiting if person is conscious.

VII. SAFE HANDLING AND USE:

Spill Procedures: Soak up with nonflammable absorbent material and place in suitable containers for chemical disposal.

Waste Disposal: Dispose of all material in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.

VIII. SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION:

Respiratory Protection: Wear a NIOSH approved organic vapor/mist respirator if vapors or mists are generated or if exposure limits are exceeded.

Protective Gloves: Impervious gloves are recommended. Butyl rubber gloves provide the best protection. Wash gloves before removal to prevent skin contact.

Eye Protection: Safety goggles are recommended. Wear a facial shield if splashing hazard exists.

Ventilation: Local exhaust is recommended to stay below exposure limits.

IX. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS:

Handling and Storage: Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Avoid breathing vapors and contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Wash thoroughly after handling. Store in a cool, dry place.
