



**MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET**

**Name:** EDEMACO

**VI. HEALTH HAZARD DATA:** Primary routes of entry: INHALATION, SKIN.

**Hazard Identification:**

**INHALATION:** May cause nose and upper respiratory tract irritation. Severe exposure may cause coughing, shortness of breath. Can cause dizziness, nausea, visual impairment, and drowsiness.

**SKIN:** Contact causes irritation, dryness, redness, dermatitis, or sensitization.

**EYE CONTACT:** May cause severe irritation, redness, pain, and corneal burns.

**INGESTION:** Poisonous if swallowed. Can cause irritation of the gastrointestinal tract, abdominal pain, diarrhea, dizziness, headache, and blindness, or death. Chronic overexposure to methanol has been suggested as a cause of eye damage in humans. Medical conditions aggravated by exposure: central nervous system, liver, and kidney conditions.

**INHALATION:** Remove person to fresh air immediately. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, administer oxygen. Contact a physician.

**SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash with soap and large amounts of water until no trace of chemical remains (15-20 minutes). Contact a physician.

**EYE CONTACT:** Flush with large amounts of water for 15 minutes. If irritation persists, contact a physician.

**INGESTION:** If person is conscious, wash out mouth with water and contact a physician immediately.

**VII. SAFE HANDLING AND USE:**

**Spill Procedures:** Eliminate ignition sources. Soak up with absorbent material and place into containers for chemical disposal.

**Waste Disposal:** Dispose of all material in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.

**VIII. SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION:**

**Respiratory Protection:** If exposure limits are likely to be exceeded, use NIOSH/MSHS approved respirators equipped with the appropriate cartridges.

**Protective Gloves:** Impervious gloves are recommended.

**Eye Protection:** Safety goggles are recommended.

**Ventilation:** Local exhaust is recommended to stay below exposure limits.

**IX. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS:**

**Handling and Storage:** Do not breathe vapor. Do not get in eyes, skin, or on clothing. Avoid prolonged or repeated exposure. Wash thoroughly after handling. Store in cool, dry place. Exposure to 110°F (43°C) will cause browning and coagulation of product.
