

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET

Name: PERMAFLOW V-2

VI. HEALTH HAZARD DATA: Primary routes of entry: EYES, SKIN, INHALATION. No chronic health effects are expected.

Hazard Identification:

INHALATION: Breathing mist may cause nasal discomfort.

SKIN: Low potential of causing irritation following exposure. Not absorbed topically. Some reddening of skin may occur with lengthy exposure.

EYE CONTACT: May cause mild irritation.

INGESTION: No significant signs or symptoms indicative of any adverse health hazard are expected to occur as a result of ingestion. Large amounts may cause gastric disturbances.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:

INHALATION: None required.

SKIN: Wash well with soap and water. Remove contaminated clothing. Launder before re-use.

EYE CONTACT: Immediately flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, contact a physician.

INGESTION: None required.

VII. SAFE HANDLING AND USE:

Spill Procedures: Soak up with non-combustible absorbent material and remove. Clean remaining residue with water.

Waste Disposal: Dispose of all material in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.

VIII. SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION:

Respiratory Protection: Not necessary where area is properly ventilated.

Protective Gloves: Rubber or other waterproof gloves are recommended.

Eye Protection: Safety goggles are recommended.

Ventilation: General precautionary measures suggest use with adequate ventilation.

IX. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS:

Handling and Storage: Keep container closed when not in use. Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing.
