

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET

Name: RESTORATIVE

VI. HEALTH HAZARD DATA: Primary routes of entry: INHALATION, SKIN.

Hazard Identification:

INHALATION: Can cause dizziness, nausea, visual impairment, respiratory failure, muscular incoordination, and narcosis.

SKIN: No adverse effects expected.

EYE CONTACT: Exposure to high vapor concentrations, or contact with liquid causes redness and irritation.

INGESTION: Causes irritation of the gastrointestinal tract, nausea, vomiting, and diarrhea.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:

INHALATION: Remove person from contaminated area to fresh air. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, administer oxygen. Contact a physician.

SKIN: Wash thoroughly with soap and water if necessary.

EYE CONTACT: Flush with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes. If irritation persists, contact a physician.

INGESTION: If conscious, drink large amounts of water, milk, or sodium bicarbonate to dilute material in stomach. Induce vomiting by placing finger in back of the throat. Contact a physician immediately.

VII. SAFE HANDLING AND USE:

Spill Procedures: Eliminate ignition sources. Use absorbent material to soak up spilled material. Remove absorbent material to a disposal area.

Waste Disposal: Dispose of all material in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.

VIII. SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION:

Respiratory Protection: Not necessary where area is properly ventilated.

Protective Gloves: None required.

Eye Protection: Safety goggles are recommended.

Ventilation: Local exhaust is recommended to stay below exposure limits.

IX. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS:

Handling and Storage: Avoid prolonged or repeated breathing of vapor. Avoid contact with eyes. Store in closed containers in a cool place. Do not smoke in areas of use or storage.
