

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET

Name: KALOCHROME POWDER

VI. HEALTH HAZARD DATA: Primary routes of entry: INHALATION.

Hazard Identification:

INHALATION: Prolonged exposure may cause lung injury. Acute exposure may cause mechanical irritation and discomfort. Any dust aggravates pre-existing respiratory conditions.

SKIN: Not a skin irritant. May cause granuloma formation in open wounds.

EYE CONTACT: Not a primary irritant. May cause mechanical irritation.

INGESTION: Unlikely to be toxic by ingestion.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:

INHALATION: Remove to fresh air.

SKIN: Wash off with water.

EYE CONTACT: Flush with running water. Contact a physician if discomfort persists.

INGESTION: Contact a physician if discomfort develops.

VII. SAFE HANDLING AND USE:

Spill Procedures: Sweep up and place in covered container. If appropriate, use gentle water spray to wet material to minimize dust generation.

Waste Disposal: Dispose of all material in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.

VIII. SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION:

Respiratory Protection: Use NIOSH/MSHA approved respiratory equipment for dust protection in the absence of adequate engineering controls to keep exposure below limits.

Protective Gloves: Impervious gloves are recommended for any embalming procedure.

Eye Protection: Safety goggles should be adequate.

Ventilation: Local exhaust is recommended to stay below exposure limits.

IX. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS:

Handling and Storage: Keep container closed when not in use. Wash up thoroughly after handling. Do not breathe dust.
