



**MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET**

**Name:** VELVO COSMETICS THINNER

**VI. HEALTH HAZARD DATA:** Primary routes of entry: INHALATION, SKIN.

**Hazard Identification:**

**INHALATION:** Excessive inhalation of vapors can cause nasal and respiratory irritation, dizziness, fatigue, headache, and possible unconsciousness or death.

**SKIN:** Prolonged or repeated contact can cause moderate irritation, defatting, and dermatitis.

**EYE CONTACT:** Can cause severe irritation, redness, tearing, and blurred vision.

**INGESTION:** Can cause gastrointestinal irritation, vomiting, and diarrhea.

**Emergency and First Aid Procedures:**

**INHALATION:** Remove person to fresh air. If breathing has stopped, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, administer oxygen. Contact a physician.

**SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing (launder before re-use). Wash skin with large amounts of soap and water. If irritation persists, contact a physician.

**EYE CONTACT:** Flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes. Contact a physician.

**INGESTION:** Do not induce vomiting. **NOTE:** Aspiration of material into lungs can cause chemical pneumonitis, which can be fatal. Keep person warm and quiet. Contact a physician immediately.

**VII. SAFE HANDLING AND USE:**

**Spill Procedures:** Eliminate ignition sources. Soak up the spill with non-combustible absorbent material. Remove absorbent material to a chemical disposal area.

**Waste Disposal:** Dispose of all material in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.

**VIII. SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION:**

**Respiratory Protection:** Use NIOSH/MSHA approved equipment if necessary to maintain exposure below limits.

**Protective Gloves:** Rubber, neoprene, or nitrile gloves are recommended.

**Eye Protection:** Safety goggles are recommended.

**Ventilation:** Local exhaust is recommended to stay below exposure limits.

**IX. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS:**

**Handling and Storage:** Keep bottle tightly closed when not in use. Avoid use in unventilated area where ignition may occur.

Avoid breathing of vapor and contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Store away from heat or open flame. Wash thoroughly after handling.
