

MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET

VI. HEALTH HAZARD DATA: Primary routes of entry: INHALATION, SKIN, INGESTION.

Hazard Identification:

INHALATION: Low levels of airborne dust can result in respiratory irritation and inflammation.

SKIN: Prolonged or repeated contact can cause dryness, leading to irritation and dermatitis.

EYE CONTACT: Can cause moderate eye irritation and/or redness.

INGESTION: Slightly toxic. LD50 (rat) = >5000 mgs/kg.

Emergency and First Aid Procedures:

INHALATION: Remove person to fresh air.

SKIN: Wash skin well with soap and water. Launder clothing before re-use.

EYE CONTACT: Flush eyes with water for at least 15 minutes. Contact a physician if necessary.

INGESTION: Give large quantities of water and induce vomiting if person is conscious. If discomfort persist contact a physician.

VII. SAFE HANDLING AND USE:

Spill Procedures: Clean up solid/liquid material carefully. Remove absorbent material to a chemical disposal area. Avoid adding water, the product will become slippery when wet.

Waste Disposal: Dispose of all material in accordance with federal, state, and local regulations.

VIII. SPECIAL PROTECTION INFORMATION:

Respiratory Protection: NIOSH approved purifying respirators should be used whenever dust levels exceed exposure limits.

Protective Gloves: Impervious gloves with non-slip coating or surface.

Eye Protection: Safety goggles are recommended. Do not wear contact lenses.

Ventilation: Local exhaust is recommended to control airborne levels below exposure limits.

IX. SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS:

Handling and Storage: Store in a cool, dry area. Keep containers closed to avoid moisture pickup. Wash hands thoroughly after handling. Wet material becomes slippery.
